As a result of one of the CCT Focus Groups during the COVID outbreak the Food Larder was started at TIDE TURNERS in Sutton-on-Sea which continues to work alongside the Furnichurch Larder. This winter arrangements have been made with ELDC to have **warm packs** available for those in need.

Another concern has been the drift of **sand** on to the promenades & the resulting blocking of the drains causing water to accumulate. Partly due to CCT representations to the Environment Agency work has now started moving some of the sand away from the defences to create gullies & so unblock the drains. A proposal has also been made to form a team of volunteers to aid the Streetscene officers in the management of sand. 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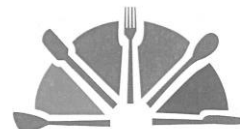

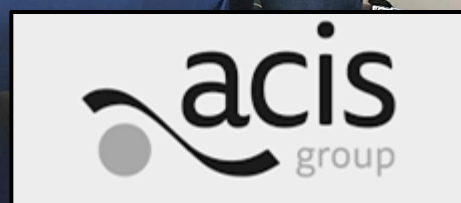

Thanks to **£8.6m** government funding from the Ministry of Housing, Communities & Local Government negotiated by the **Connected Coast Towns Fund Board, ACIS**, which is currently responsible for the **CLIP** college in Seacroft Road, will be seeking to utilize the two new two-story buildings & open green space on Stanley Avenue to create opportunities for learning, research & wellbeing for generations to come.

It is a flagship & internationally significant project in which the University of Lincoln & the Lincoln Institute for Rural & Coastal Health will be supporting research into the health inequalities that affect coastal communities like our own & seeking ways to meet these economic & medical challenges in such a way as to turn them into nationally significant strengths with services being improved & new jobs being created. First steps towards realizing this vision will be taken next spring when the learning & well-being activities of CLIP will relocate to these new premises.



While maintaining its pleasingly good rating from Ofsted & seeing heartening exam results this summer, during the coming autumn **CLIP** will be continuing to support those in their late teens with the inspiring **FLARE** programmes that take in creative writing, drama & script design, social action, the digital media & radio podcasts



... but now new shorter & snappier **SPARK** sessions will be offered for those feeling their way towards discovering new skills & qualifications.
