As well as providing CLIP with a new home where its educational work will be able to expand these facilities will with the help of Lincoln University further a range of medical initiatives with conference facilities such as those provided a few days after the opening on 24th June for the **Coastal Mental Health Partnership** seen in these photos.

This is a **double decker bus** that will be touring Withern, Theddlethorpe & Mablethorpe with free family activities, light refreshments, & offering opportunities to learn new skills. All will be welcomed aboard to take part in a new 'seaside' themed programme.

The CLIP team will be joined by partners from Mablethorpe Library, One You Lincolnshire, Lincoln & Lindsey Blind Society, & the National Trust to set off on a two week tour bringing arts & crafts activities & scavenger trails that will be sure to broaden the experience of old & young.





The Lincs & Notts Air Ambulance Charity is gearing up to save more lives than ever with the addition of a second helicopter.

The charity, which saves lives across Lincolnshire & Nottinghamshire has secured a spot on the production line in Italy for a new helicopter at a cost of around **£7m**.

LNAAC currently operates with one helicopter, its iconic yellow AW169. But as mission numbers rise, the doctors, paramedics & pilots who respond to an average of four missions a day, know that there are patients they can't currently get to.

Medical Director **Dr Gareth Davies** said: "We want to bring our skill & experience to the side of more patients, more quickly, & across a wider area. A second aircraft is a game-changer for these patients & for us as we expand what we can do to meet the needs of the communities that we serve."

The charity is completely funded by donations & the project has taken flight thanks to initial fundraising efforts which have raised **£4m**.

The Michael Cornish Charitable Trust & BNA Charitable Incorporated Organisation have each given **£1m** towards the second helicopter. The Jones 1986 Charitable Trust and Nottingham based company Experian have also made generous contributions to the project, along with LNAAC contributing thanks to its fundraising efforts.

The plan for a second helicopter emerged after data gathered by the charity showed there are people in need who the service cannot get to with just one aircraft. In the last five years, the charity has seen a 135 % increase in mission numbers & recent data has shown that there's an average of 1.4 missions every day the crews are not able to currently respond to. The second helicopter will be an AW109 GrandNew model & is scheduled to land at the charity in summer 2027 with a view to being fully operational by autumn that year.

LNAAC's CEO **Karen Jobling** said: "We are absolutely delighted to share this incredible news with our supporters. The addition of a second helicopter means that we will be able to attend more emergencies, more quickly, and provide critical care to more patients who might not otherwise have access in time. This is truly a life-changing development for the communities we are here to serve. Every life we save is a thanks to the people who support LNAAC.

The second helicopter will belong to everyone who has ever donated, fundraised, or supported us in any way. It will save many more lives, & we could not achieve this without them."

It was good to hear how a team of volunteers will now be working alongside the ELDC Street Scene Team, the Environment Agency, & the National Trust rangers in taking steps to face this challenge.

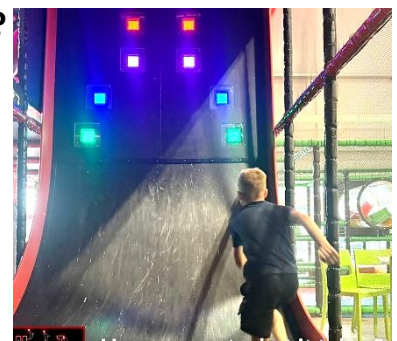

In April 2024 the Children & Young People of Mablethorpe produced a document **"10 things young people need"**.

Item 1 was **"a safe, indoor space just for young people to hang out in, or to connect with youth workers"**
& this has now become a reality.

Mablethorpe Area Partnership has leased from ELDC what used to be the ATC Hut on Sherwood Fields with this aim. The LCC run Youth Club is meeting there each Wednesday, the cubs will be meeting there on Tuesdays, daytime tuition & activities are led by the Butterfly Foundation, & the Royal British Legion will also be meeting there: it's ideal for such daytime groups given its easy parking. As part of the SO Festival a stunning Graffiti was created & there's a photo of it on the back page of this TIDINGS.

The Hut now boasts an array of facilities including its **Multipurpose Hall**: Ideal for workshops, events, & gatherings.

Creative Spaces: Equipped for art, music, & drama activities.

Technology Zones: Computers & internet access for learning & job searches.

Outdoor Areas: Playgrounds & green spaces encouraging physical activity & environmental awareness.

Counselling Rooms: Private areas for mental health & well-being support.
