Remembering all those who have walked, worked and defended our Nature Reserve

Hubert Eastwood

A few weeks into WW1, on the 01 Sep 1914, Hubert walked our coast and sent this post-card to his sister, Eleanor.

He was a doffin plate maker in his father's business at the Engine Bridge Works, Chapel Hill, Huddersfield, and a keen cricketer with the Primrose Hill Club. But, on the 05 Jan 1917, he gave that up and joined the 9th Battalion, The Northumberland Fusiliers.

He was killed in action, aged 25, at Merville, France, on the 09 Aug 1918, unaware that he had contributed to what became the decisive offensive of the war.

His brother, Albion, died in a Prisoner of War Camp in Germany on the 18 Oct 1918, an early victim of the flu pandemic
