TIPS FROM THE POLICE: Issued 6th March

- Take stock** – where do you owe money? At what interest rates?
- Work out your budget** – what money do you have coming in, what do you need to pay for & what's left for paying off debt?
- If you're looking to make savings** – check that you're not overpaying for your bills& utilities. Where can you make savings?
- Set up a separate bill account** – transfer an amount each month to cover the cost of all your household bills. This will give you greater control over your finances & ensure you do not make late payments.
- Set yourself saving goals** – saving regularly could provide you with a financial buffer for any unexpected bills or be used to save for short term purchases or long-term aspirations.
- Check your bank balance** – regularly, to avoid nasty surprises.
- Review your mortgage** – to see if you can reduce your monthly outgoings, check with your provider or an independent mortgage advisor.
- Review your insurance** – Why not see if you could save money by changing your home or car insurance provider.
- Check your credit score** – using one of the various companies available online including [Experian](https://www.experian.co.uk), [Equifax](https://www.equifax.co.uk), or [TransUnion](https://www.transunion.co.uk).
