The Day of Prayer is celebrated in over 146 countries. It begins in Samoa, & prayer in native languages travels throughout the world – through Asia, Africa, the Middle East, Europe & the Americas before finishing in American Samoa some 38 hours later.

World Day of Prayer is an international, inter-church organisation led by women which enables us to hear the thoughts of women from all parts of the world; their hopes, concerns & prayers. The preparation for the day is vast. An international committee is based in New York & there are national committees in each participating country. Regional conferences meet to consider the service and then local groups make their plans.

THIS YEAR the Christian Women of Palestine are calling us to connect with the land from which Jesus came... where he was born, ministered & died. It is here that our faith began & is rooted. Despite living in an area of the world where there is ongoing conflict & the future is uncertain, the women of Palestine are sharing with love a reminder that they are there & that they want to give hope to everyone.

The theme of the service 2024 'bear with one another in love' seems very appropriate for these women who will not give up witnessing the love of Jesus Christ.
