STRANDED ANIMALS along our coasts

If you come across a stranded seal, dolphin, porpoise or whale, you can help by knowing what to do and who to call.

If you think a seal is sick, injured or an abandoned pup, send for help, ensuring that the caller can give an accurate description of the animal. Keep people and dogs away until help arrives. Keep noise at a minimum to avoid further stress to the animal.

Marine animals are wild animals. Do not attempt to move or drag the animal. This could harm and distress them even more and - they bite!
