SUTTON-ON-SEA SEAFRONT

Piling work will begin on site from week commencing 5th February. This will see a specialist contractor installing 85 driven piles which will form the foundations for the new building. This vital piece of work will cause increased noise levels on site but will be kept within normal working hours & be contained within the usual industry standards. This is expected to take around 3 weeks to complete.

Once this is completed work will start on the construction of ground beams to link the piles together, along with the insertion of drainage for the building. This will allow the installation of the steel frame to follow later in the spring.

STATION LEISURE & LEARNING CENTRE

Work is progressing well with the installation of the heating system, & air handling ducts. The render coat of the swimming pool is complete & wall tiling is underway at the changing areas. Work is running to schedule with the facility due to be completed in the coming months.

East Lindsey committed to becoming an Age-friendly community in 2019. In 2021 they became a member of the WHO Global Network of Age-friendly Communities.

East Lindsey District Council have been working with Lincolnshire Community and Voluntary Service to develop an Age-friendly Ambassador scheme.

The Age-friendly Ambassador Role:

- This is a voluntary role for an adult aged 50+.
- Ambassadors can give as much, or as little time, depending upon what suits them.
- Ambassadors will be involved in communicating Age-friendly messages, including tackling ageism. This will largely be within their own personal life networks. For example, in their workplace, social groups, places of worship or with family and friends.
- Ambassadors could be involved in co-designing, with partner organisations, initiatives and developments across the district.

The Ambassador role suits anyone that is willing to connect with others and is passionate about having their say on issues affecting older people.

Ambassadors will also be invited to attend regular Age-friendly Forum meetings and will be able to contribute to an Age-friendly Newsletter.

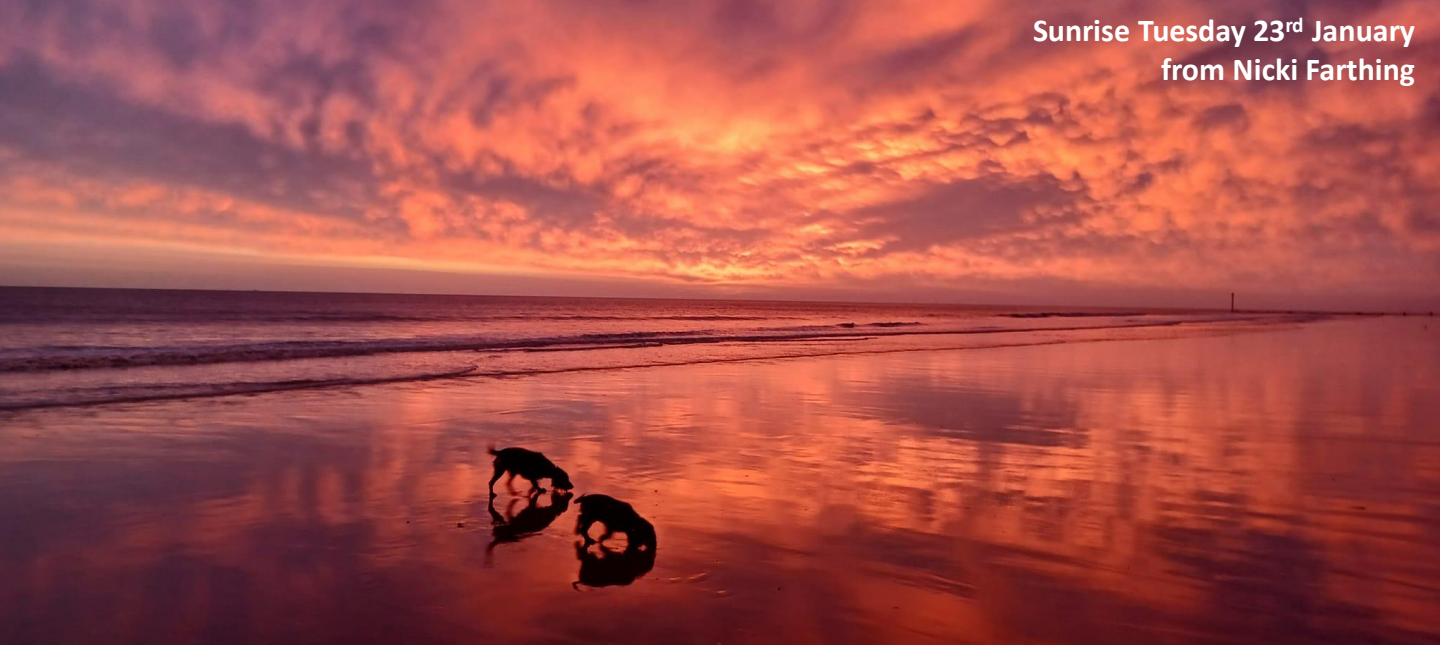
